Today, we announced an enterprise-wide relocation program to our MetLife employees. Over the next two years, close to 2,600 non-sales positions in the U.S. will be relocated in phases to two newly-created MetLife campuses, here in North Carolina.

The decision to relocate has been made with tremendous concern for our employees, who have each been essential to our success. We are committed to providing support for them throughout the entirety of this transition.

We are also looking forward to expanding our MetLife family during this process, and, in turn, becoming a part of the greater North Carolinian community. We will be recruiting a large number of new associates in Raleigh and Charlotte from a variety of sources, including local universities.
